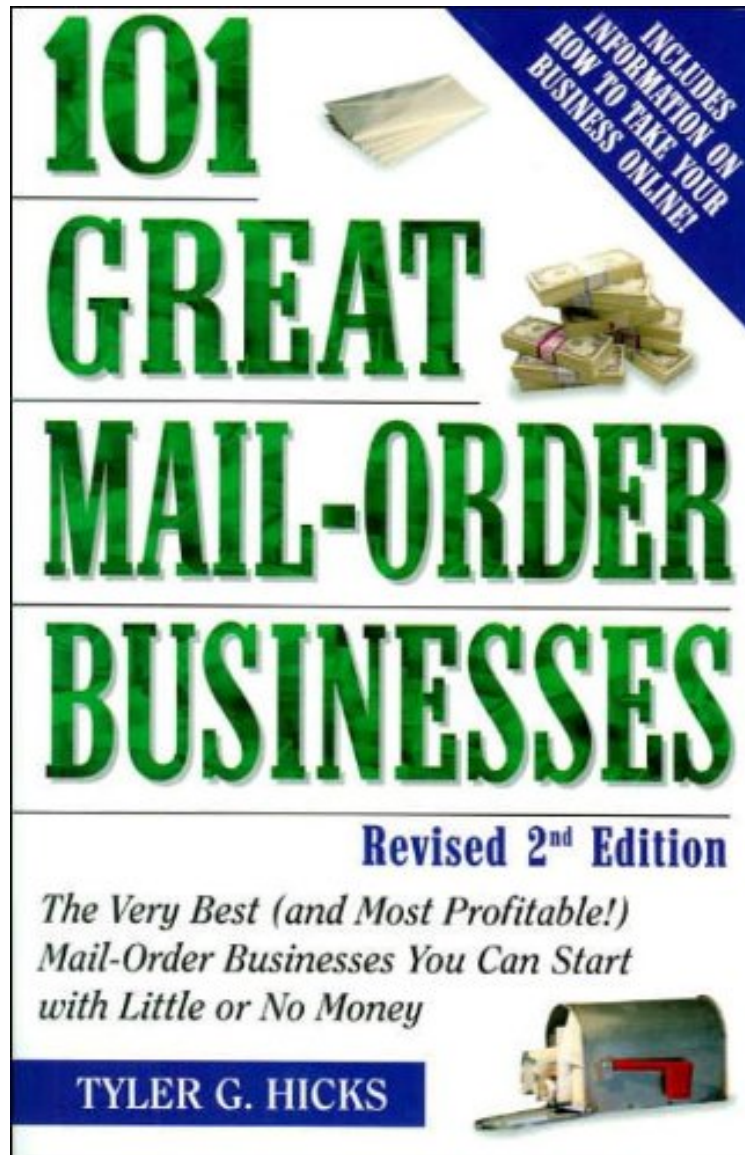

This one of the first books that I have read that actually makes you think you are reading a sales pitch for a product (his), and while he does have over 101 ideas... they are just listed with little depth. He tells you why they are good ideas/products, but nothing about how to make, find, buy, or market them to consumers. Also most of his ideas can be found for free online. I found very little value of the book and wish I never bought it.
