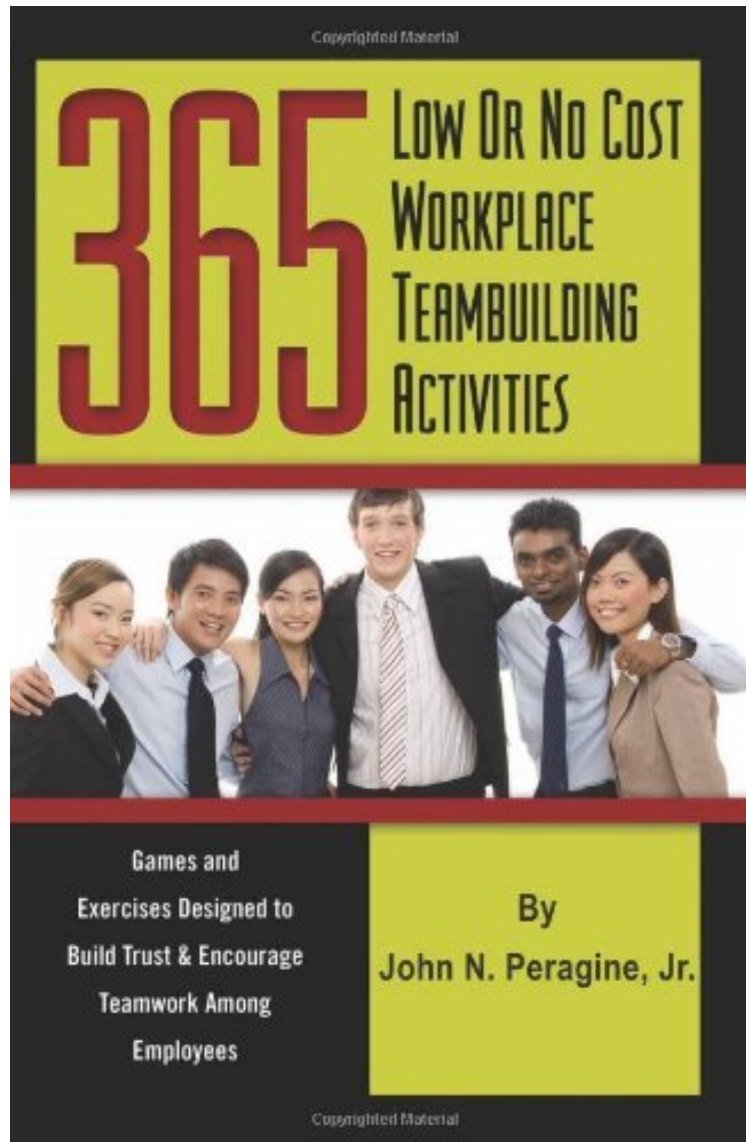

Having worked in the corporate world for 16 years before becoming a teacher I can appreciate the author's efforts to provide practical and low cost solutions to building teamwork in the office place. I can also tell after reading this book that the inept boss (played brilliantly by the actor Gary Cole) in the movie `Office Space' did not benefit from the author's wisdom. I also know that many others can relate to having that kind of boss, and want to avoid that at all costs.
