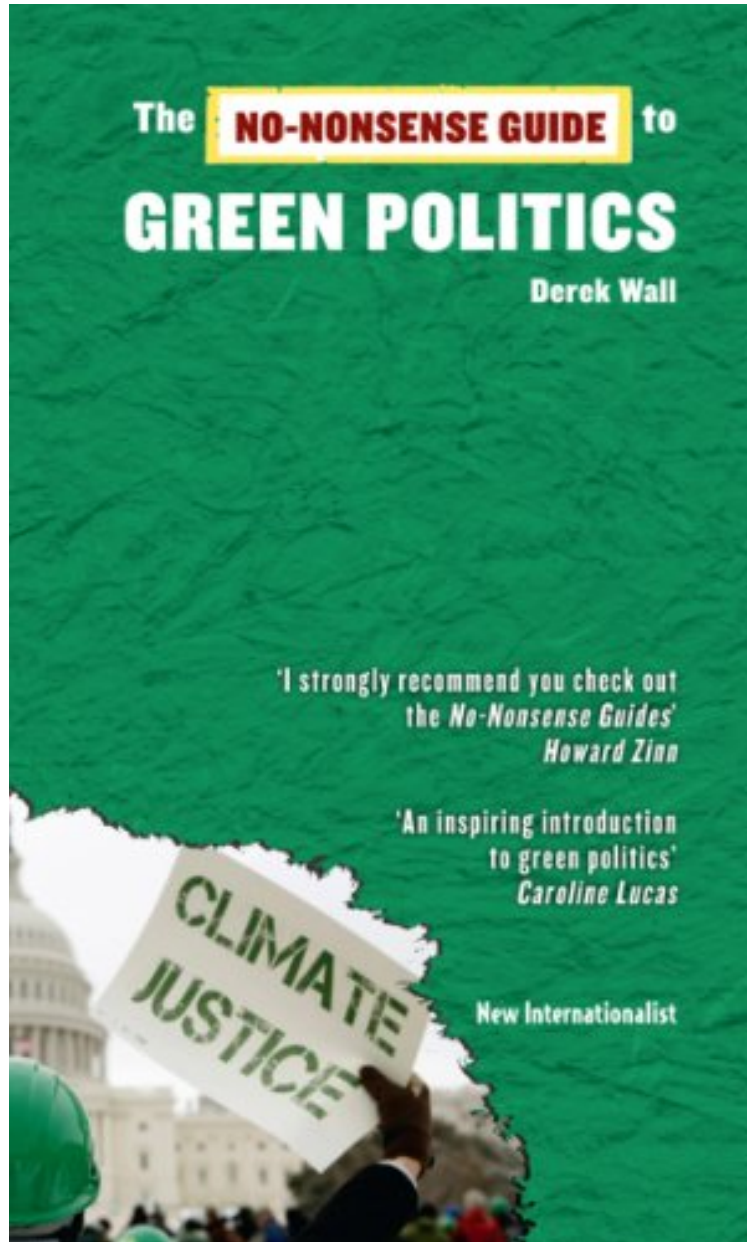

Lots of interesting content, but the logical structure of the book is difficult to follow.
