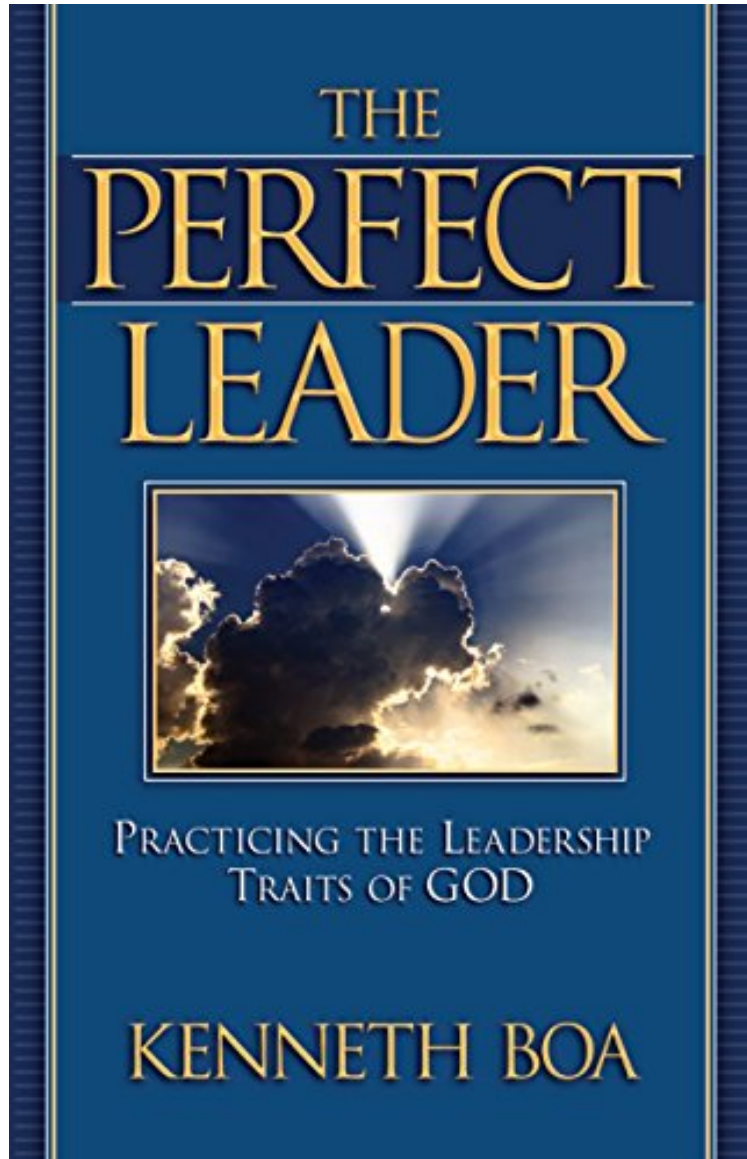

attributes, skills and relationships of the perfect leader respectively. The attributes include integrity, character, values, purpose and passion, humility, and commitment; the skills include vision casting, innovation, decision making, problem solving, and team building; the relationships include communication, encouragement, exhortation, building relationships, and servant leadership. There are plenty of books available on leadership in general and Christian leadership in particular. This book aims to be a bit different by beginning with God as the ultimate model of leadership, and focusing on particular attributes of God to provide insights on leadership principles, hopefully prompting the reader to engage in self-examination.
