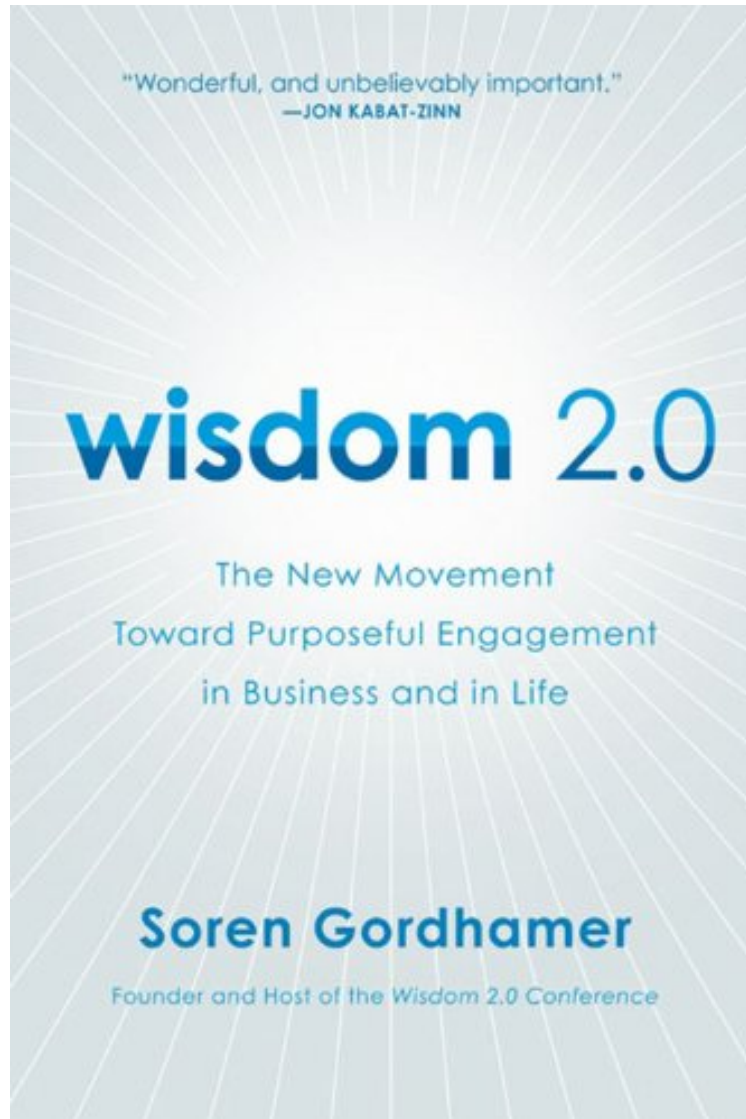

Each chapter follows a very clear and concise

pattern: He first does a great job of presenting situations with which anyone in a technology-related or creativity-dependent field is familiar: things not working, colleagues not cooperating, feeling dependent on our gadgets, experiencing declines in creativity and productivity, etc. He then helps you realize the emotions you are really feeling, many of which are easily overlooked in the heat of a stressful or difficult moment. And finally, he presents interesting and directly applicable ways to deal with these troubling situations and emotions. Almost every chapter is also complemented with anecdotal teachings of Zen masters or just stories of his own experiences. I'm definitely a newbie when it comes to meditative and mindfulness practices, so that should be taken into account. But overall, after about a month spent reading this book off and on, I feel much more in tune with my emotions, actions, and reactions in difficult moments and I've experienced a general increase in creativity and productivity.
